**Now the Lord said to Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, “This month shall be the beginning of months for you; it is to be the first month of the year to you. Speak to all the congregation of Israel, saying, ‘On the tenth of this month they are each one to take a lamb for themselves, according to their fathers’ households,**

**a lamb for each household. Now if the household is too small for a lamb, then he and his neighbor nearest to his house are to take one according to the number of persons in them; according to what each man should eat, you are to divide the lamb.**

## **Ex 12:1-4**

**Your lamb shall be an unblemished male a year old; you may take it from the sheep or from the goats. You shall keep it until the fourteenth day of the same month, then the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel is to kill it at twilight. Moreover, they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and on the lintel of the**

**houses in which they eat it. They shall eat the flesh that same night, roasted with fire, and they shall eat it with unleavened bread and bitter herbs. Do not eat any of it raw or boiled at all with water, but rather roasted with fire, both its head and its legs along with its entrails. And you shall not leave any of it over until morning, but whatever is left of it until morning, you shall burn with fire. Ex**

## **12:5-10**

**Now you shall eat it in this manner: with your loins girded, your sandals on your feet, and your staff in your hand; and you shall eat it in haste—it is the Lord's Passover. For I will go through the land of Egypt on that night, and will strike down all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and**

**beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgments—I am the Lord. The blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you live; and when I see the blood I will pass over you, and no plague will befall you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt. ‘Now this day will be a memorial to you, and you shall celebrate it as a feast to the Lord; throughout your generations you are to celebrate it as a permanent ordinance.**

## **Passover at Moses’s time**

- The plague of death *passed over* those who ate the **flesh of the lamb**

and put its **blood** on the doorposts of their home.

- God commanded Israel to celebrate this Passover event every year. Why?
- This was more than just remembrance, it was to help them accept the true Passover Lamb who was coming.

**Clean out the old leaven so that you may be a new lump,**

**just as you are in fact  
unleavened. For  
Christ our Passover also  
has been sacrificed.**

**Jesus the Passover**

**Lamb** • Jesus came as the Lamb of God to

atone for sin (Jn 1:29) in fulfillment of the prophecies about the savior but also to fulfill the copy and shadow of the Law's animal sacrifices.

- *For **the life of the flesh is in the blood**, and I have given it to you on the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is **the blood by reason of the life that makes atonement.**' (Lv 17:11)*
- Jesus also came as the Passover Lamb (1 Cor 5:7). Those who ate his flesh & blood (Jn 6:51-53) were set free from slavery to sin and death in the world of the synagogues (Jn 5:24-25) and led into the promised land of the Kingdom of Heaven.

**“I am the living bread that came down out of heaven; if anyone eats of this bread, he will live**

**forever; and the bread also which I will give for the life of the world is My flesh.” Then the Jews began to argue with one another, saying, “How can this man give us His flesh to eat?” So Jesus said to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, **unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in yourselves.****

**Jn 6:51-53**

**Truly, truly, I say to you, he who hears My**

**word, and believes Him who sent Me, has eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life. Truly, truly, I say to you, an hour is coming and now is, when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God, and those who hear will live.**

**Eating Jesus's flesh & blood**

- What did Jesus mean when he told his followers to eat his flesh and blood?
- Jesus came into this world as the Word of God made flesh (1 Jn 1:1-2, Jn 1:1-4, 14), which meant Jesus's words were the Word of God and life.

Just as Lv 17:11 said there is life in the blood, there was spiritual life in Jesus's words. Eating his flesh and blood was accepting his words.

- *It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing; the words that I have spoken to you are spirit and are life. (Jn 6:63)*
